CPCNA Education Bursary 2025 - Cycle 1

The CPCNA is pleased to offer an education bursary to help offset the cost of continuing education that will advance your practice in palliative care nursing. This bursary can be applied toward any eligible education expense, including graduate studies, a conference, a course, or any other educational offering that CPCNA determines to be relevant. This bursary covers up to \$499 of the cost of any such expense.

Please note: CPCNA will allocate these bursaries according to availability of funds. There may be more funds available to support more bursaries in some years as compared to others. A SIN number is required to receive this bursary. Potential applicants who do not yet have a SIN can still apply for this bursary, and then request a SIN number once selected. This would likely delay receipt of funding.

To be eligible for this bursary, applicants must:

- Be a CPCNA member in good standing, and have been a member since at least the previous year;
- Not have access to other funds (e.g., from an employer or other professional source) to pay for the educational activity.

As a condition of receiving the bursary, recipients are expected to renew their CPCNA membership for the next calendar year. Recipients are also expected to provide a photo, bio, and short reflection about how this bursary contributes to the recipient's professional development and nursing practice, to be posted on the CPCNA website. Finally, recipients must not have other funds available to them, for example through their employer, to fully cover the costs of the educational activity being supported by CPCNA.
